

Hay Crop Silage

Hay crop silages are silages made from perennial crops typically grown for hay. In Western Canada, these include:

- legumes such as alfalfa and clover;
- grasses such as brome, timothy, perennial ryegrass, orchardgrass and the wheatgrasses;
- mixtures of perennial legumes and grasses.
